111 PLEASURE DRIVING

Prize Money: 1st £30.00; 2nd £20.00; 3rd £10.00

Open to horses or ponies, 4 years and over, any vehicle (including pneumatic tyres.) To be judged 15% on vehicle suitability (fit and cleanliness), 15% on harness suitability (fit and cleanliness) and 70% on the driver and groom, the horse / pony's way of going and suitability as a family pleasure drive. All competitors may be required to drive and halt between 2 pairs of cones and execute a U-turn in their individual show.
